WHAT IS THE DUBUQUE SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA LEAGUE (DSOL)?

The **DSOL** and its board is a volunteer group that started in 1967. Its goal is to support the financial and educational efforts of the Dubuque Symphony Orchestra (**DSO**).

Some of these efforts include funding the DSO's Adopt a Musician program - dedicated to enhancing the music education of fourth grade students in Dubuque and the tri-state area, the Youth Concerto Competition, Senior Classics and the list goes on.

In 2023 the DSOL contributed over \$33,000 to the DSO.

HOW WE DO THIS:

We contribute our time and talents to a diverse variety of projects. Some of the activities we are planning this Season include but are not limited to:

- **ARTS TREK** – educational concerts specially designed for 3rd and 5th grade students. The DSOL ushers over 2,500 students into and out of the concert hall. We also supply an orchestra luncheon as part of the 3rd grade Arts Trek.
- **CONCERT GREETER** - Greet concert attendees and hand out the programs.
- **MUSICAL MUSINGS** – Sunday concert goers enjoy a pre-concert talk with Maestro Intriligator.

- **SOUND BITES** - informative and entertaining luncheon talks with Maestro William Intriligator and the concert guest artists.
- **SENIOR CLASSICS** - small DSO ensembles perform at local assisted living centers.
- **PLAYING BRIDGE FOR THE SYMPHONY** - Calling all bridge players for a social and fundraising event – a day of bridge, lunch & more bridge on Thurs., September 26.
- **FALL FASHION SHOW** – November is going to be a fun month for the League. Watch for news of the next afternoon of fashions, furs, food and fun
- **“GERANIUMS PLUS” SALE** - gorgeous geraniums, hanging baskets, and armloads of other plants for sale in the spring.
- **I LOVE THE SYMPHONY** - Your ideas turned into fundraisers: wine tasting, game night, yoga party, and gourmet dinners are a few examples!
