*Mileage:\$0.23 per mile: Musicians living 50 miles or more outside of Dubuque will be compensated for mileage for actual round trips taken up to a maximum of three round trips per Classics concert set. Musicians living 15-50 miles from Dubuque will be compensated for actual round trips taken up to a maximum of five trips per Holiday Pops and Classics concert sets.

**The DSO's Adopt-a-Musician program assigns a single DSO musician to each elementary school in the area (currently 17+ participating schools). That musician is expected to visit their assigned schools a minimum of five times per school year and at least two visits must occur in the first semester. The Adopt-a-Musician program pays each participating musician \$1000 per school per year. Participating musicians may be assigned to more than one school each year. Concertmaster candidates are not automatically assigned to this program and participation would be based on interest, qualifications, and availability of schools.
