Each year the Dubuque Symphony Orchestra presents free concerts to 5th and 3rd graders from area schools as a way to introduce young students to symphonic music and the various instruments in the orchestra. These concerts are held at The Five Flags Theatre in downtown Dubuque. Last year, approximately 1,700 5th graders from 37 schools heard Maestro Intrilligator and the DSO perform music choices depicting the evolution of style, from Mozart to John Williams' Star Wars to 'My Shot' from the musical Hamilton. The 2,550 3rd graders from 46 area schools were treated with performances demonstrating individual instruments and orchestra sections. A solo was performed by Bret Tomkins, a tuba player from Hempstead High School, who was this year's winner of the youth concerto contest, which was sponsored by the League.

This year the 5th Grade Concerts were held on Thursday, Oct. 12. The 3rd Grade Concerts will be held on Thursday, November 2. The DSOL provides the ushers for these concerts and welcomes your participation as a volunteer.
