Musicians living 15-50 miles from Dubuque will be compensated for actual round trips taken up to a maximum of five trips per Holiday Pops and Classics concert sets.

**Housing:** Overnight housing accommodations shall be provided upon request at no charge to musicians who must travel more than 15 miles one way to any service on consecutive days. As availability allows, musicians shall have the option to stay in private homes at no charge to them or at a reduced-rate hotel at no expense to the DSO.
